The **Center for Health, Human Rights and Development (CEHURD)** currently has opportunities for **Program Associates**. The ideal candidates should have commitment to work with a dynamic organization working on issues of Health and Human Rights. The selected candidates bring their professional skill sets and work with one or more of CEHURD's programs and/or departments for a period of one year with a potential for extension. The candidate will contribute towards the strategic goals of CEHURD.

The opening is for four competitive positions across its programs. The candidates should clearly indicate which of the four positions below they are applying for:

- i. **Program Associate:** Strategic Litigation (SL) – This program engages in litigation aimed at influencing systemic change towards fulfilment, recognition and protection of health rights in Uganda; and providing redress where individual human rights violations have occurred.
- ii. **Program Associate:** Research, Documentation and Advocacy (RDA) – DA as a program aims at documenting, influencing and advocating for human rights, health policies, plans, laws and best practices that impact and improve social justice in health, access to medicines, and human rights in Eastern Africa.
- iii. **Program Associate:** Community Empowerment (CEP) - This program aims at creating a mass movement on health and human rights. Through CEP, CEHURD mobilizes communities to create knowledge and awareness in order to bridge the gap between rights holders and duty bearers, to contribute to the realisation of health and human rights.
